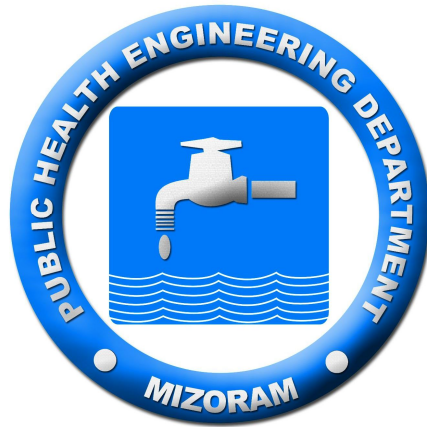

Envelope-2:- Financial bid. Ref: CPWD Works Manual Para 15:7.1.1) with sealed item rate tender in prescribed form affixing Court Fee Stamp worth Rs. 7.5/- (non refundable) for non tribal and up-to-date House Tax Payee Certificate for tribal from reputed contractors experienced in similar type of works. The tender will be received in the office of the undersigned upto **12:00 hours** on **20/03/2018**. Late submission of tender will not be accepted. The tender so received will be opened on **20/03/2018** at **14:00 hours** in presence of the intending tenderer or his authorized representative. If for any unforeseen reason, the Tenders could not be received & opened on the stipulated date & time, the same will be received and opened in the next working day at the same time for which no separate communication will be made.

**NOTICE INVITING TENDER  
(TENDER NO CE(Z-II)PHED-2 OF 2017-2018)**

1. Item rate tenders are invited on behalf of Governor of Mizoram from reputed contractors for the work: **Construction of Dam Reservoir & development of Recreation Centre at Keilungliah, Champhai**

The enlistment of the contractors should be valid on the last date of sale of tenders.

In case the last date of sale of tender is extended, the enlistment of contractor should be valid on the original date of sale of tenders. In case both the last date of receipt of application for issue of tenders and sale of tenders are extended, the enlistment of contractor should be valid on either of the two dates i.e. original date of sale of tender or on the extended date of sale of tenders.

- 1.1 The work is estimated to cost **Rs. 192,371,000.00** inclusive of all taxes viz. GST, Cess etc etc.
- 1.2 Tenders will be issued to reputed contractors provided they produce definite proof from the appropriate authority, which shall be to the satisfaction of the PHE Department.
- 1.3 The Tenderer must have executed during the last 7 years, ending on last day of the month previous to the one in which the tenders are invited;
  - a. Three **Civil** works of water supply scheme each value not less than 40% of estimated cost put to tender or
  - b. two **Civil** works of water supply scheme each value not less than 60% of estimated cost put to tender or
  - c. one **Civil** work of water supply scheme value not less than 80% of estimated cost put to tender.

(All figures to be rounded off to a convenient full figure)

2. Agreement shall be drawn with the successful tenderer on prescribed Form No. CPWD 7/8.
3. The time allowed for carrying out the work will be **36 months** from the date of start as defined in schedule 'F' or from the first date of handing over of the site, whichever is later, in accordance with the phasing, if any, indicated in the tender documents.
4. The site for the work is available.
5. Tender document consisting of plans, specifications, the schedule of quantities of the various classes of work to be done and the set of terms & conditions of contract to be complied with by the contractor whose tender may be accepted and other necessary documents can be seen in the office of **the Chief Engineer (Z-II), PHED, Mizoram, Aizawl.** between hours of 11.00 AM & 4.00 PM from **05/03/2018** every day except on **Saturday and Sundays and Public Holidays to 19/03/2018**
6. Tender documents, excluding standard form, will be issued from his office, during the hours specified above, on payment of **Rs. 1500/-** (Rupees one thousand five hundred only) in cash.
7. Tenders must be accompanied with **Earnest money of Rs. 29,23,710.00** in the form of Bank Guarantee/ fixed deposit receipt of a scheduled bank/demand draft of a scheduled bank issued in favour of **the Chief Engineer (Z-II), PHED, Mizoram, Aizawl.**

The tender and the earnest money shall be placed in separate sealed envelopes, each marked “Tender” and “Earnest Money” respectively. Both the envelopes shall be submitted together in another sealed envelope with the name of work and due date of opening written on envelope. The envelop marked “Tender” of only those tenderers, whose earnest money are in order and placed in the other envelope shall be opened, and .any tender not accompanied by specified earnest money shall be rejected.

8. The contractor whose tender is accepted will be required to furnish performance guarantee of 5% (Five Percent) of the tendered amount within the period specified in Schedule F. This guarantee shall be in the form of Deposit at Call receipt of any scheduled bank/Banker’s cheque of any scheduled Bank/ Demand Draft of any scheduled bank/or Government Securities or Fixed Deposit Receipts or Bank Guarantee Bonds of any Scheduled Bank or the State Bank of India in accordance with the prescribed form. In case the contractor fails to deposit the said performance guarantee within the period as indicated in Schedule ‘F’ including the extended period if any, the Earnest Money deposited by the contractor shall be forfeited automatically without any notice to the contractor.
9. Canvassing whether directly or indirectly, in connection with tenderers is strictly prohibited and the tenders submitted by the contractors who resort to canvassing will be liable to rejection.
10. The competent authority on behalf of Governor of Mizoram reserves to himself the right of accepting the whole or any part of the tender and the tenderer shall be bound to perform the same at the rate quoted.
11. The contractor shall not be permitted to tender for works in the Circle/ Division responsible for award and execution of contracts, in which his near relative is posted as Divisional Accountant or as an officer in any capacity between the grades of Superintending Engineer and Junior Engineer (both inclusive). He shall also intimate the names of persons who are working with him in any capacity or are subsequently employed by him and who are near relatives to any Gazetted Officer in the Department. Any breach of this condition by the contractor would render him liable to be removed from the approved list of contractors of this Department.
12. No Engineer of gazette rank or other Gazetted Officer employed in Engineering or Administrative duties in an Engineering Department of the Government of Mizoram is allowed to work as a contractor for a period of one year after his retirement from Government service, without the previous permission of the Government of Mizoram in writing. This contract is liable to be cancelled if either the contractor or any of his employees is found any time to be such a person who had not obtained the permission of the Government of Mizoram as aforesaid before submission of the tender or engagement in the contractor’s service.
13. This notice inviting Tender, along with latest **General conditions of Contract for CPWD Works** shall form the basis of the contract document. The successful tenderer/contractor, on acceptance of his tender by the Accepting Authority shall within 15 days from the stipulated date of start of the work, sign the contract agreement:-
14. The department shall deduct CESS & TDS (under GST) as admissible on the value of work done from each bill of the contractor as per prevailing Government instruction/orders. In lieu, the department shall issue a certificate of deduction of the Tax at source the contractor.
15. **Quoted rate above estimated amount shall be summarily rejected .**

16. No tender will be considered for acceptance unless the detailed tender papers are duly purchased by the intending tenderer. A copy of the receipt for the money deposited against purchase of the tender document shall have to be submitted along with the tender as a proof of purchasing the same.
17. **Tenderer has to read all terms and conditions of this tender documents carefully. All tender documents need not be submitted. Tenderer has to submit form-6 and Proforma of Schedules, signed on both sides of each paper of the tender documents as a token of acceptance of the terms and conditions mentioned therein. Other documents of this tender need not be submitted, if otherwise specified to submit. Tenderer has to accept and comply with all terms and conditions of this tender.**
18. Defect liability period of the contract shall be 12 (twelve) months from the date of commissioning. Any defect noticed in the system during this period shall have to be rectified by the contractor at his/ their own cost and risk .
19. The Public Health Engineer Department, Govt. of Mizoram, reserves the right to add, amend or to delete any of the items of work or part thereof and the contractor shall carry out the same as per the instruction of the Engineer-in-Charge.
20. The Public Health Engineer Department, Govt. of Mizoram takes no responsibility for delay, loss or non-receipt of tenders sent by post. Unsealed tenders or Telex/Telegraphic/Fax offers shall not be considered for acceptance.
21. The tender documents shall remain the property of the Public Health Engineering Department, and if obtained by one intending tenderer, shall not be used by any other tenderer.
22. The tender shall be completely filled in all respects and shall be tendered together with requisite information. Any tender incomplete in all particulars shall be liable to be rejected.
23. If any contradiction arises in any clauses of the NIT, clauses in CPWD form-8 supersede all other clauses of the NIT.
24. The bidder must have adequate experiences on Design, Construction ,testing and Commissioning of Concrete Gravity Dam . Documentary support for the above must be submitted along with the tender.
25. List of the staffs and their details including their educational qualifications and experiences shall be submitted along with the tender.
26. Bidder shall have to submit copy of GST registration certificate issued by the appropriate authority.
27. The terms, conditions and specifications mentioned in tender document shall be binding on the tenderers and no condition or stipulation contrary to the conditions shall be acceptable. It may please be noted that the tenderers who do not accept terms and conditions stipulated in this tender documents, their offers shall be liable to be rejected out-rightly without assigning any reason whatsoever.

Each page of tender document & enclosures shall be signed by the tendered. All the pages of the documents issued must be submitted along with the offer. The pages of the tenders should be submitted in proper way in an organized manner else the tenders may be cancelled.

28. Rate quoted should include all kind of taxes, cess, insurance & royalty for forest product etc.
29. Tenderer must visit the proposed project site at Keilungliah Champhai, Champhai District of Mizoram to conduct the thorough site survey and the feasibility studies of the project on his own expenses and shall submit the design containing the feasibility report. The tenderer shall also submit all the design parameters. The tenderer should also obtain a site visit certificate from the concerned SDO and shall be submitted in original along with the tender. Tenders submitted without the site visit certificate shall be summarily rejected. The Department shall scrutinize thoroughly each Design of all tenderers and shall only consider the tenderer(s) whose design is/are found to be technically and economically feasible under the Climatic condition of Mizoram.
30. Offer of those parties who are found qualified based on the Technical Evaluation will only be taken for further consideration and the commercial bid of only those parties will be opened. The party should have sufficient technically qualified and well-experienced manpower for execution of the project. List of the staffs and their details including their educational qualifications and experiences, who are proposed to be engaged for the execution of work shall be submitted along with the tender.
31. PHED reserves the right to reject or accept any or all tenders wholly or partly without assigning any reason on the grounds considered advantageous to the Department whether it is the lowest tender or not.
