**A. TERMS & CONDITIONS :**

- 1) Tender document may be downloaded from the website <https://phed.mizoram.gov.in>
- 2) Manufacturers should produce valid BIS License as on date of NIT.
- 3) Quotation should be submitted in two sealed covers. The first cover shall contain the documents relating to eligibility criteria and the envelope should be super scribed as TECHNICAL BID. The second sealed cover shall contain price bid and to be super scribed as PRICE BID. The technical bid will be opened first in presence of all participating bidders and if the technical bid qualifies, then only price bid will be opened. Otherwise the tender will be declared non-responsive/informal. The two sealed Covers are to be submitted in a large sealed cover to be superscripted Quotation No, Name of the Quotation and the date of opening.
- 4) The quantities shown are tentative and subject to change based on actual requirement.
- 5) The rates will be F.O.R Aizawl inclusive of all kinds of taxes, duties, insurance, transportation, loading, unloading etc. Bidders must quote the net Price both in words as well in figures. Any over writing/cutting etc render the tender invalid.
- 6) Total price should indicate the breakup of statutory payments (like GST, Inspection Fees, Transportation etc.) either in percentage or lump sum on the quoted price. Price quoted shall remain valid for a period of one year from the date of opening of tender.
- 7) All documents are to be submitted with quotation duly authenticated notarized.
- 8) Tenders received after the due date & time of opening shall not be accepted.
- 9) If the Office is closed on the stipulated date and time due to some unforeseen reason, quotation will be received up to and open in the next working day at the same place and time.
- 10) Quotation paper must be duly filled in all columns of the tender documents. No over writing will be allowed.
- 11) Manufacturers should have experience in manufacturing of G.I pipes and as per IS specification of diameter varying from 15mm of medium and heavy class and above for at least 5 years and the product should have given satisfactory performance for at least 5 years.
- 12) Manufacturers (Bidders) should produce valid PAN no., GST clearance Certificate/ Partnership deed/ Memorandum of Articles/ ROC Registration Certificate.
- 13) Each & every page of NIT must be signed by the Bidder.
- 14) Incomplete quotation will not be accepted.

- 15) No escalation/discount will be entertained afterwards during the validity.
- 16) No conditional offer will be accepted.
- 17) The Bidder or his authorized representative may or may not be present at the time of opening the tender. However, they are advised to be present to ensure open and fair selection process.
- 18) Offers from Bidders who have been found guilty in any criminal case by a court of law and or declared blacklisted by any Government/ Semi-Government/ Department/ Institution of the Central or State Government will be summarily rejected.
- 19) PHE Department does not bind itself to accept the lowest or any quotation and reserves the right to reject in part or in full or all tenders received.
- 20) PHED reserves the right to postpone/cancel the quotation without giving any reason.
- 21) Third party inspection shall be arranged by the manufacturer at no extra cost from Third Party Inspection Agencies registered and certified by The National Accreditation Board for Certification Bodies (NABCB) for inspection of GI Pipes. Materials will only be accepted on production of the inspection certificates.

**B. TECHNICAL SPECIFICATIONS :**

- 1) All pipes shall have as Cast or Stamped or legibly and indelibly painted on with the following appropriate mark:
  - a) Manufacturer name or Trade Mark
  - b) I.S no that is, IS 1239 (Part-I) : 2004
  - c) Class of pipes, that is M or H for Medium or Heavy class.
- 2) The different classes of Pipes shall be distinguish by 75mm colour bands, which shall be applied as follows before the tubes leave the manufacture's work:
  - 1) Medium class- Blue
  - 2) Heavy class- Red
- 3) The zinc coating on the pipes shall be in accordance with IS 4736. (360g per square meter).
- 4) Each pipe shall be tested for leak tightness as in – process test at manufacturer's work by Hydrostatic test. The Hydrostatic test shall be carried out at a Pressure of 5MPa & the same should be maintained for at least 3 second & shall not show any leakage in the pipe. The authentic Hydrostatic test certificate carried out must be produced at the time of submission of quotation and supply of materials. Quality control authority certificate may be attached.
- 5) The thickness, dimension, nominal mass and maximum permissible pressure of pipes should be maintained as per table 4, table 5 and table 6 of IS 1239 (Part-I) : 2004. Tolerance shall be permitted on the Pipes & Sockets as per IS 1239 (part-I) : 2004.
- 6) The Pipes should be socketed at one end and the other end should be protected with Plastic ring protector. Socket is to be fitted so tightly to pipe end that it should not fall down during handling or transit. The socket so fitted must be as per IS-1239 (part-I) 2004 is respect of OD and length.
- 7) All pipes shall be clearly finished & reasonably free from injurious defects. The ends shall be free from sharp edges burrs of the pipe. The pipes shall be reasonably straight.

### C. ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA :

- 1) The Bidder should have an Average Annual Financial Turnover **of at least 40% of his quoted price** during the immediate last 3 consecutive balance sheets (may range from six to eighteen months) duly audited by Chartered Accountant. Year In which no turnover is shown would also be considered for working out the average. Information may be furnished as per **Appendix-IV**, and may be included in technical Bid.
- 2) The Bidder should not have incurred any loss in more than two years during the last five consecutive balance sheets, duly certified and audited by the Chartered Accountant.
- 3) Bidders having the following experience of successfully completed works to any Central or State Government Department during the last 5 years are eligible to apply. The total quantity supplied to a single Government Department during a financial year shall be considered as a single **Completed Work**. The quantities supplied to different Government Departments shall be considered as **Separate Works** even if they are during the same financial year:
  - a. **Three similar Completed Works** not less than the amount equal to **40% of total quantity** put to tender, OR
  - b. **Two similar Completed Works**, not less than the amount equal to **60% of the total quantity** put to tender, OR
  - c. **One similar Completed Work** not less than the amount equal to **80% of the total quantity**. Information to be provided as per **Appendix-VI** and included in Technical Bid.

- 8) All Bidders must submit a list of their owners/partners etc. and a Certificate to the effect that the firm is neither blacklisted by any Govt. Department nor any Criminal Case is registered against the firm or its owner or partners anywhere in India.
